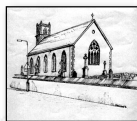

Numbers will be limited and you may not get your "regular" seat. Face Masks must be worn – No Exceptions to this.

Bookings for seats will be taken through the Parish Office only (028) 71882274, from 10.00am on Monday 9th November until 4.00pm on Thursday 10th December 2020. As seating is limited it is advised to book early.

For Parishioners who may feel uncomfortable or who are unable to attend Mass on Christmas Eve or Christmas Day (there is no obligation to attend Mass at the present time), you may celebrate your Christmas Mass any day of that week from Monday 21st December until Sunday 27th December.
