Visitation of the Sick

Unfortunately due to the ongoing restrictions due to Covid-19, Bishop Donal McKeown has issued the following message to all parishes in the Diocese of Derry."I have been asked for further guidance on the routine visitation of the sick and housebound as part of 'First Friday' or similar visits. I have concluded that this should not take place, at the moment, due to four factors:

- 1. The sick and housebound disproportionately elderly, a group which is especially vulnerable to serious COVID infection and, indeed, death;
- 2. This group is also more likely to have significant comorbidities, which may also make them more vulnerable;
- 3. Routine visitation involves moving from one house to another, with the risk of infection being spread to multiple households:
 - **4.** Daily infection rates, both north and south, are trending upwards, after the relatively low number of infections during the summer."

Leckpatrick Parish First Holy Communion

First Communions will take place in Leckpatrick Parish on Saturday 26th September. Due to restrictions because of Covid-19, the number of parishioners permitted in the church is very limited to include the following:

- Child for First Communion
- Child's Parent(s)/Guardian(s)

There can be NO Exceptions to these rules. First Communions Mass will take place in the following way:

Children from St. Mary's P.S., Cloughcor being seated in the Church by 10.45am. Their First Communion Mass will take place at 11.00am.

Children from Strabane Controlled P.S. are to be seated by 12.45pm, their First Communion Mass will take place at 1.00pm. This is the only way to accommodate child and parents only.
